tefano Romeo is assistant professor at the Department of Molecular and Clinical Medicine at the Sahlgrenska Academy. He moved to the Wallenberg Laboratory in 2011 after a research fellowship at the University of Texas Southwestern Medical Center, Dallas, USA, and a clinical lectureship at the University of Cambridge, UK.

Dr Romeo's main research focus is the role of genetic variants in modulating metabolic traits such as serum lipid levels, insulin resistance and liver fat accumulation. His research field ranges from genetic association studies in large cohorts to molecular genetics of human mutations.

He received the Young Investigator Award from the European Atherosclerosis Society in 2008.
