



Guy Vergères

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D Dr. Guy Vergères studied chemistry at the Swiss Institute of Technology in Zürich (ETHZ). He then conducted basic research on the structure and function of proteins at ETHZ (PhD in biochemistry), at Genentech in San Francisco (visiting postdoctoral fellow in the field of molecular biology), at the Medical Center of the University of California in San Francisco (postdoctoral fellow; assistant research biochemist), and at the Biozentrum of the University of Basel (biophysical chemistry; habilitation in biochemistry). He then moved to applied research in the pharmaceutical industry at ZLB in Bern to assess the therapeutic potential (pharmacology) and the safety (toxicology) of blood-derived proteins (Head Preclinical Development; Head Research Collaboration & Innovation).

In 2004 he integrated the governmental agricultural and food research institution of Agroscope (Head Microbiology; Head Biochemistry & Physiology; currently Head Functional Nutritional Biology). Guy Vergères is also a lecturer on nutrigenomics at ETHZ and the University of Lausanne, and a member of the scientific board of Swiss Food Research.
