Endocrinology Professor, he has won several Research and Career Development Awards (Marius Tausk Award, 1995, given by the German Society of Endocrinology for the Best Researcher under 32 years old; ENEA 2002 Award by the European Neuroendocrine Association for the Best European Neuroendocrinology Researcher). He attended the Diabesity project Funded under 6th FWP (Sixth Framework Programme) and now he is participating in two European Projects under 7th FWP both related to the topic of Obesity: Reprobesity Collaborative Project entitled "*Search for new therapeutic agents against complicated obesity by reprofiling existing Drugs*" and Neurofast Large Scale Integrating Project entitled "*The Integrated Neurobiology of Food Intake, Addiction, and Stress*". He has always been interested in neuroendocrinological problems of pituitary and adrenal glands, endocrine determinants in obesity with special regard to the role of cannabinoids. Since he is in Bologna he wrote several research scientific papers on clinical jobs ranging from polycystic ovary syndrome to visceral obesity, from the role of endocannabinoids to adrenal masses. From 2016 he is Director of UOC Endocrinology where all endocrinological pathologies are followed, as well as Director in function of the UO Diabetology of S.Orsola Clinical Company. He is a member of the Board of Directors of the Italian Society of Endocrinology (S.I.E.): Winner of the SIE 2011 Prize awarded to Montesilvano in May 2011.
